

## TRAVOPROST INTRAOCULAR IMPLANT CLINICAL STUDY

To qualify, you must:

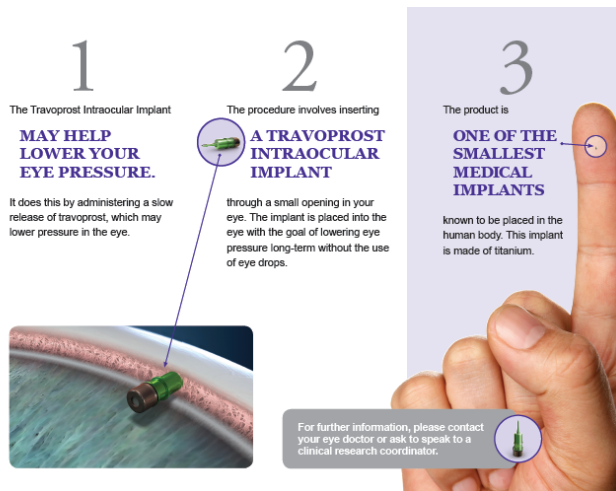
- Be 18 years of age or older

- Follow-up visits for up to three years
- Reimbursement for costs related to time and travel

## HOW YOU CAN PARTICIPATE

An intraocular implant containing a slowly releasing travoprost medication will be placed in your eye through a tiny opening in the cornea.
